#### **RECOMMENDED DIET:**

A mix of Dry and Wet high quality food.

Supermarkets/Commercial dog foods are mostly filled with fillers and poor quality ingredients that lead to kidney and liver disease.

As a general rule, high quality dog foods have a shorter ingredients list, more fiber, less or no corn or other grains and high protein.

Always read the ingredients list; a whole source of animal protein should always be the first ingredient, such as fish, poultry or meat.

## Green Paws

- Alcoholic beverages
- Apple seeds
- Apricot pits
- Avocados
- Cherry pits
- Candy (particularly chocolate—which is toxic to dogs, cats, and ferrets—and any candy containing the toxic sweetener Xylitol)
- Chives
- Coffee (grounds, beans, and chocolate-covered espresso beans)
- Garlic
- Grapes
- Gum (can cause blockages and sugar-free gums may contain the toxic sweetener Xylitol)
- Hops (used in home beer brewing)
- Macadamia nuts
- Moldy foods
- Mushroom plants
- Mustard seeds
- Onions, onion powder and onion flakes
- Peach pits
- Potato leaves and stems (green parts)
- Raisins
- Rhubarb leaves
- Salt
- Tea (because it contains caffeine)
- Tomato leaves and stems (green parts)
- Walnuts
- Xylitol (artificial sweetener that is toxic to pets)
- Yeast dough

### **Tips:**

- A dog can take a minimum of 8 days to decompress at home. Please be patient and calm.
- Take the dog for a 20min walk before entering the home. Multiple walks for the first 3 days are recommended for the dog to decompress.
- Update us twice a day so we can guide you
